*COVID-19 Disease Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2020*

NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 14 AND 16

I, PETER CARL GUTWEIN, the Premier, being of the opinion that the relevant emergency circumstances exist in relation to this notice and with the approval of the emergency manager –

(a) in pursuance of section 14 of the *COVID-19 Disease Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2020*, amend, for the period for which this notice has effect under that Act, each provision that specifies the period for which a permit is in effect, that –

- (i) is contained in a permit that is issued under section 143, 169, 193 or 260 of the *Building Act 2016* (“the Act”) or that is contained in a permit that is taken to be issued under the Act by virtue of clause 6 of Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the Act; and
- (ii) is in effect immediately before the day on which the making of this notice is published in the *Gazette* –

by extending the period specified in the provision so that the period ends 6 months after the day on which, but for this notice, the period would end; and

(b) in pursuance of section 16 of the *COVID-19 Disease Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2020*, extend, for the period of 6 months after the day on which, but for this notice, the period would end, the period for which a permit that –

- (i) is issued under section 143, 169, 193 or 260 of the Act or that is taken to be issued under the Act by virtue of clause 6 of Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the Act; and
- (ii) is in effect immediately before the day on which the making of this notice is published in the *Gazette* –

is in effect by virtue of a provision of the Act.
